




TSHOKEY DORJI FOUNDATION

## Introduction

Close to the exalted sacred land of Bodhgaya, where a garland of thousand Buddhas of good fortune attained enlightenment. lies the medicinal land of Bhutan – a hidden paradise (Baeyul) under the glorious reign of the Bodhisattva Kings of the Wangchuck Dynasty, imbued with the teachings of the Buddha and tamed by the Maha Guru Padma Sambhava. Against this backdrop, motivated by the great benefit of Buddha's teachings to the sentient beings, His Eminence the 7th Namkhai Nyingpo Rinpoche Jamyang Yeshey Tenpai Gyeltshen Palzangpo, the lineage holder and primordial wisdom manifestation of Nub Namkhai Nyingpo, consecrated Tshokey Dorji Foundation under his divine patronage to uphold, protect, and disseminate the precious teachings of the Buddha. 



## **Background of the Tshokey Dorji Foundation**

The Tshokey Dorji Foundation is an apolitical and a non-profit organization established on 31st July, 2009, registered under the Religious Organizations Act of Bhutan 2007.

It was established by His Eminence the 7th Namkhai Nyingpo Rinpoche Tenzin Gyeltshen, his disciples, and the devoted benefactors. The primary objective is to uphold, protect, and disseminate the precious teachings of the Buddha.

The Foundation is governed by a Board of Trustees constituted from its members. The Board members include at least two (2) Khenpos from the Council of Khenlops of Bumthang Kharchhu Monastery. The members serve in the Board as volunteers. The Foundation has a permanent office in Thimphu, Bhutan headed by the Executive Director. 




### **Objectives of the Foundation**

The main objectives of the Foundation are the following:

- Provide financial support and other non-financial assistance necessary for the continued sustenance of Bumthang Kharchhu Monastery and it's branches as a peak of study and practice of the Buddha Dharma and thereby serve to hold, support and disseminate the teachings of the Buddha;
- Organize Dharma Teachings (Choeshed Layrims) to the devotees and general public;
- Provide support to the aggrieved individuals and organizations during times of disasters;
- Organize and conduct prayers for the peace and wellbeing of the King, Country and the People;
- Support the members of the Foundation during times of illness and deaths to conduct prayers (Tshedup, Ngo Moenlam, etc.) by coordinating with Bumthang Kharchhu Monastery or its affiliates, as appropriate;
- Generate and provide fund for continued sustenance of affiliate monasteries, Dharma centers, and institutions both within and beyond Bhutan; and
- Provide subsistence and other livelihood support to the revered members of the Sangha in general including monks, nuns, and Gomchens.



#### Sources of Fund for the Foundation

As an apolitical and non-profit organization, the primary source of fund for the Foundation comes from: (i) its members in the form of membership fees; and (ii) donations from the benefactors.

Any individual person or a legal entity can become a member of the Foundation by contributing a minimum annual membership fee of Nu. 1,200/-. The Foundation accepts donations both in kind and in cash. The Foundation also organizes the Annual Tshigduen Soeldep Bumthrak Chenmo which helps in mobilizing additional funds. The Foundation endeavors to explore any other possible avenues to raise funds. To become a member of the Foundation or to provide donation to the Foundation, individuals are encouraged to contact the addresses provided in the back page of this brochure. Any donations including membership fees made to the Foundation are exempt from taxation by law.

# Monasteries & Dharma Centers sustained under the patronage of His Eminence Namkhai Nyingpo Rinpoche



The head abbots (Lams) and monks/nuns of all these monasteries, institutions and meditation centers add up to more than one thousand members of the Sangha. They are taken care and managed by and under the guidance and patronage of His Eminence Namkhai Nyinpo Rinpoche as the fountain head of these institutions.
